Ticks

We have had pest control out to spray our field and grassed areas. Whilst we are not certain that ticks are a problem on school grounds, we have been alerted that generally they are being found in increased numbers.

The advice we have been given is that ticks are becoming more widespread in all grassed areas (not just where livestock are found). Parents should be mindful to check their children, especially on the neck and behind their ears. A special tick remover tool can be bought to remove the tick safely. Medical advice should be sought for children after ticks have been removed.
